

Excellence in Construction Award

ASCE Sacramento Section of the Construction Institute created the Excellence in Construction Award in 2011 to recognize Construction Industry Leaders for innovation in quality and safety performance. The first award is planned to be presented in September 2011.

In 2011, the Sacramento Section of the Construction Institute named the award the **Dan Hart Excellence in Construction Award** in honor of the first Industry Advisor to the Sacramento Section Construction Institute.

Eligibility: Candidate must be a Construction Industry Leader in charge of the most innovative and high quality construction projects and safety programs.

Nomination Criteria: The nomination will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- **Innovation** – Introducing something seen as a change in the thought process translated into improved quality and safety of the constructed project.
- **Quality**– Set the vision and outcome for constructing a project free from defects, deficiencies brought about by the strict and consistent adherence to measurable and verifiable standards that satisfies specific owner’s requirements .
- **Safety** – Set the vision and outcome for constructing a project free from the occurrence or risk of injury, danger or loss that satisfies specific owner’s requirements.

Nomination Process: Nominations for this award must be made by Industry Leader and endorsed by a company executive or principal using the attached nomination form.
